

Appointment of Auxiliary Bishop of Goiânia (Brazil)



The Holy Father appointed Rev. Fr. José Roberto dos Reis, C.P., currently Novice Master and Parochial Vicar in the Diocese of São Luís dos Montes Belos, as Auxiliary Bishop of the Metropolitan Archdiocese of Goiânia (Brazil), assigning him the titular See of Feradi Minor.

His Excellency Bishop José Roberto dos Reis, C.P., was born on 22 April 1977, in São Luís do Montes Belos, in the diocese of the same name, in the state of Goiás. He entered the Congregation of the Passion (Passionists), where he completed his studies in Philosophy and Theology, made his Religious Profession on 15 January 2000, and received priestly ordination on 8 December 2003.

He has held the following positions: Formator of Postulants and Parish Vicar in Goiânia - GO (2004-2010); Member of the Coordination Group of Formators of the Passionist Family of Brazil (2005-2008); Pastor of Our Lady Auxiliadora in Iporá - GO (2010-2013); Regional Vicar of the Vicariate of Christ the Liberator in Goiás - GO (2012-2014); Novice Master in Ponta Grossa - PR (2014-2017); Formator of Postulants and Parish Vicar in Cariacica - ES (2018); and First Consultor of the Province of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross (2018-2022). He is currently Novice Master, Parish Vicar and a member of the Presbyteral Council of the Diocese of São Luís dos Montes Belos.
